

2019 ORCV Novice Skippers Race

Notice to Competitors No. 1

The Notice of Race for the 2019 ORCV Novice Skippers Race, is amended as follows:

This table replaces the table contained in Appendix A of the Notice of Race.

Specifically, the description of “Crew” is amended to describe the criteria required for crew and for the eligibility of the nominated Novice Skipper.

Check	Category	Requirement
	General	Yachts shall be built in accordance with the Special Regulations Part 1, Section 3.03 and Appendix C as applicable. The Safety Regulations shall be those of AS Special Regulations, Part 1, Category 5.
	Insurance	The owner of a yacht entered in the race shall hold a marine legal liability insurance policy with respect to the yacht, current at the time of the race, with a sum insured of not less than A\$10 million. The insurance policy shall state that the yacht is covered for the race or that it is covered for yacht races of a length greater than the race length.
	Crew	All persons sailing on competing boats shall be members of an Australian Sailing (AS) affiliated club. For the purpose of the above requirement, a Novice skipper is defined as:- <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A first-time boat owner who has competed, as boat owner or in any other capacity, in less than 10 yacht or dinghy races in the past 10 years; OR• A crew member who has no prior experience as a watch leader and who does not normally occupy the role of helms person during a yacht race.
	Radio	Each competing yacht shall carry a VHF transceiver with channels 12, 16, 67, 71, 73 and 82.
