NOTICE TO COMPETITORS No.3– Amendment to Sailing Instructions.

New Safety regulations (Section 12)

- 12.11 All persons on boats that do not have pulpits, stanchions and lifelines that comply with Australian Sailing Special Regulation Clause 3.12, shall wear a life jacket while on deck.
- 12.12 When Code Flag Y is displayed on the start boat, and/or advised by the Race Director via VHF prior to the race start, competitors shall wear lifejackets until the conclusion of the race, or until advised they are no longer compulsory. This changes RRS 40.2 (a).

3. Finish Approach, pass to Port
- C2 An additional mark is added to the table.
Finish Approach S38° 12.48' E145° 01.97 Yellow inflatable buoy*

* The inflatable buoy will have an ORCV blue logo on a white background.

SI Appendix D: Finish

- D1.2 (Changed to) The Finish line will be on an approximate bearing of 065°T from the “Finish Approach” mark, within 0.5Nm of it.
- D1.7 The finish boat will be “Little Miss Magic”, as shown below. It will be on AIS.
