NOTICE TO COMPETITORS: Changes to the Sailing Instructions

It is planned to make this race about 2-3 hours duration and the course will be adjusted to accommodate this race timing.

1. The anticipated start line will be approximately 0.75NM north-east of RGYC with the Committee Boat at the starboard end and a laid mark at the port end. Boats will start in a northeasterly direction. This modifies B4.1 of the Sailing Instructions. Depending on the wind conditions, the alternative start lines, described in B4.2 may also be used.
2. The course may be shortened at any of the marks of the course, that mark being rounded on the required hand and the Committee Boat forming the other end of the finishing line.
3. If required by the prevailing weather, the race committee can also announce, by VHF radio, an alternative finishing line, formed by a laid mark and the Committee Boat, the positions of which will be provided.
4. Radio Skeds:
At each position report, boats shall provide their position, marks passed since the last report and the ETA at the next mark.
