- ☐ The yacht's insurance policy states that the yacht is covered for this race, or the race falls within the limits of the yacht's insurance coverage.
- ☐ The number of people on board will not exceed the life raft(s) capacity.

- ☐ The yacht's crew details and the Emergency Contact details in TES are correct.
- ☐ The 2 Team Shore Contacts are not participating in the race and will be available for contact as required during the race. The Emergency Name provided for each crew member is not participating in the race and will be available for contact if required during the race.
- ☐ VHF and Sat Phone Yachts: At least two POB holds a Short-Range Operator Certificate of Proficiency (SROCP) or higher qualification. The Boat Satellite phone number is filled in on the Boat Specifications section on Topyacht.
- ☐ At least 1 POB (2 in the case of Double-handed yachts) holds a current Senior First Aid Certificate or equivalent, or is a practicing medical practitioner and is also SSSC qualified.
- ☐ At least 50% of the POB hold a current SSSC certificate. For 2-handed yachts both skippers must hold a current SSSC certificate. The skipper/sailing master must hold a current SSSC certificate.
- ☐ A Category 2 ORCV Pre-Race Equipment Checklist and Declaration will be completed prior to the start of the race and retained on board (in either electronic or printed format) for inspection if requested.
- ☐ I confirm that the keel and rudder of the yacht have been inspected in accordance with the requirements of Australian Sailing's Special Regulation 3.02.4 and Appendix C within the last 2 years and confirm that the yacht has not experienced an unintentional grounding since that inspection.
A copy of the inspection form (in electronic or printed format) is stored onboard the yacht for inspection.
- ☐ I confirm that I am satisfied that the crew have adequate experience and training for the race and that the experience requirements of Australian Sailing's Special Regulation 2.04 are satisfied.
- ☐ I am carrying the minimum fuel requirements in accordance with the NOR
OR
I have an electric propulsion engine and comply with the minimum effective range in accordance with the NOR.
- ☐ The Yacht's AIS (Automatic Identification System) is operational and complies with Australian Sailing's Special Regulation 3.29. A recent test (within 30 days of signing this form) has been done using on an online website, which confirms the yacht's AIS is transmitting the correct position.
